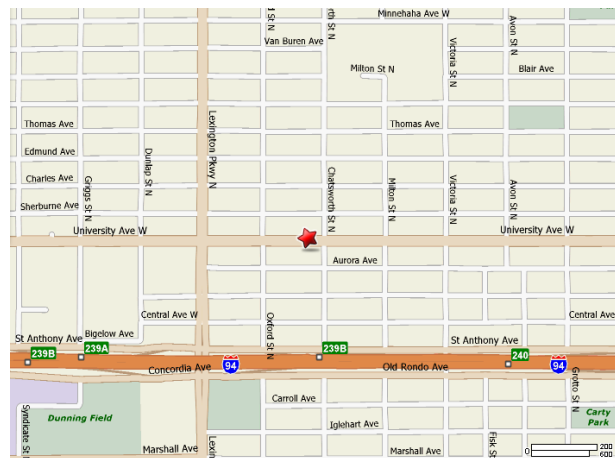

CULTURAL Folk Art PROGRAM

This 20 year old program teaches adults and youth traditional songs and rituals associated with Meej Koob (the traditional Hmong Marriage Ceremony) and Kev Pam Tuag (Funeral Customs) in order to help ensure the survival of Hmong culture and tradition. The program is divided into two parts: The Marriage (Meej Koob) ceremony class and Funeral (Kav Xwm thiab Txiv Xaiv) ceremony class. The classes are open to everyone and it is designed to facilitate cultural learning by allowing students to discover and be immersed in different areas of Hmong marriage and funeral customs.



MARRIAGE FOLK ART CLASS

The classes introduce students to the traditional Hmong marriage customs. The lessons include different reciting, chanting, ceremony processions, and general conducts that would be expected of the ceremony attendees of different status such as bride/groom, elders, and others. The classes are conducted in Hmong.

FUNERAL FOLK ART CLASS

The funeral classes function similarly to the marriage classes. They introduce students to the traditional Hmong funeral customs. The lessons include different reciting, chanting, funeral processions, and general conduct that would be expected of the funeral attendees of different status such as elders and younger people. The class is also conducted in Hmong.
