




1. Why did you or your group want to participate in a Building Bridges Presentation from the Hmong Cultural Center?




2. Please pick the category that best describes your profession (Please choose one category only).



3. How would you rate your satisfaction with the presentation that was provided in terms of educational value? (Please Choose One Answer Only)




4. Please provide below specific examples of the Building Bridges program content that found particularly helpful (i.e. subject topics covered).




Some of the attendees felt that the culture and resettlement of the Hmong people in the United States are necessary to know, especially in their profession.


