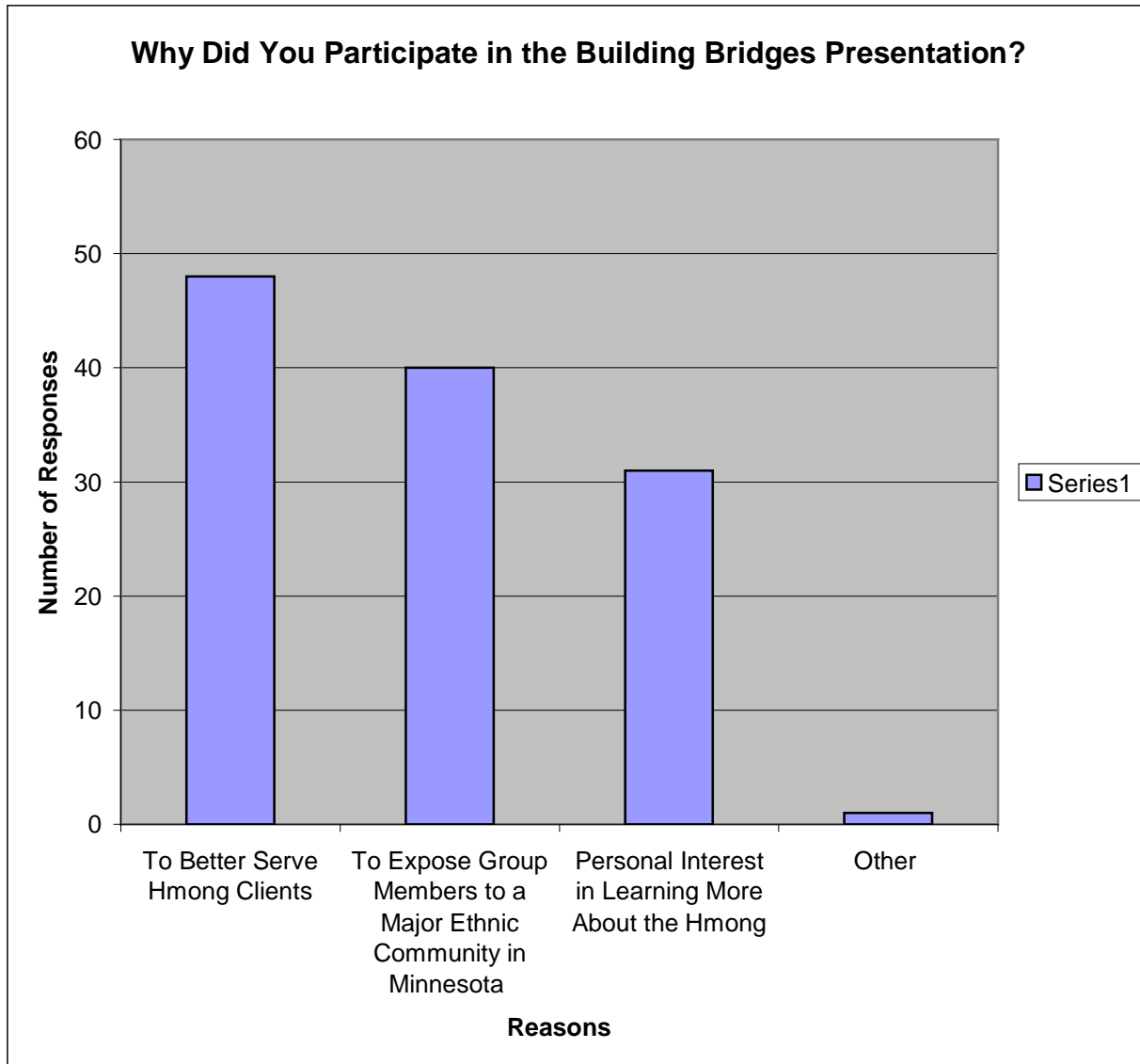

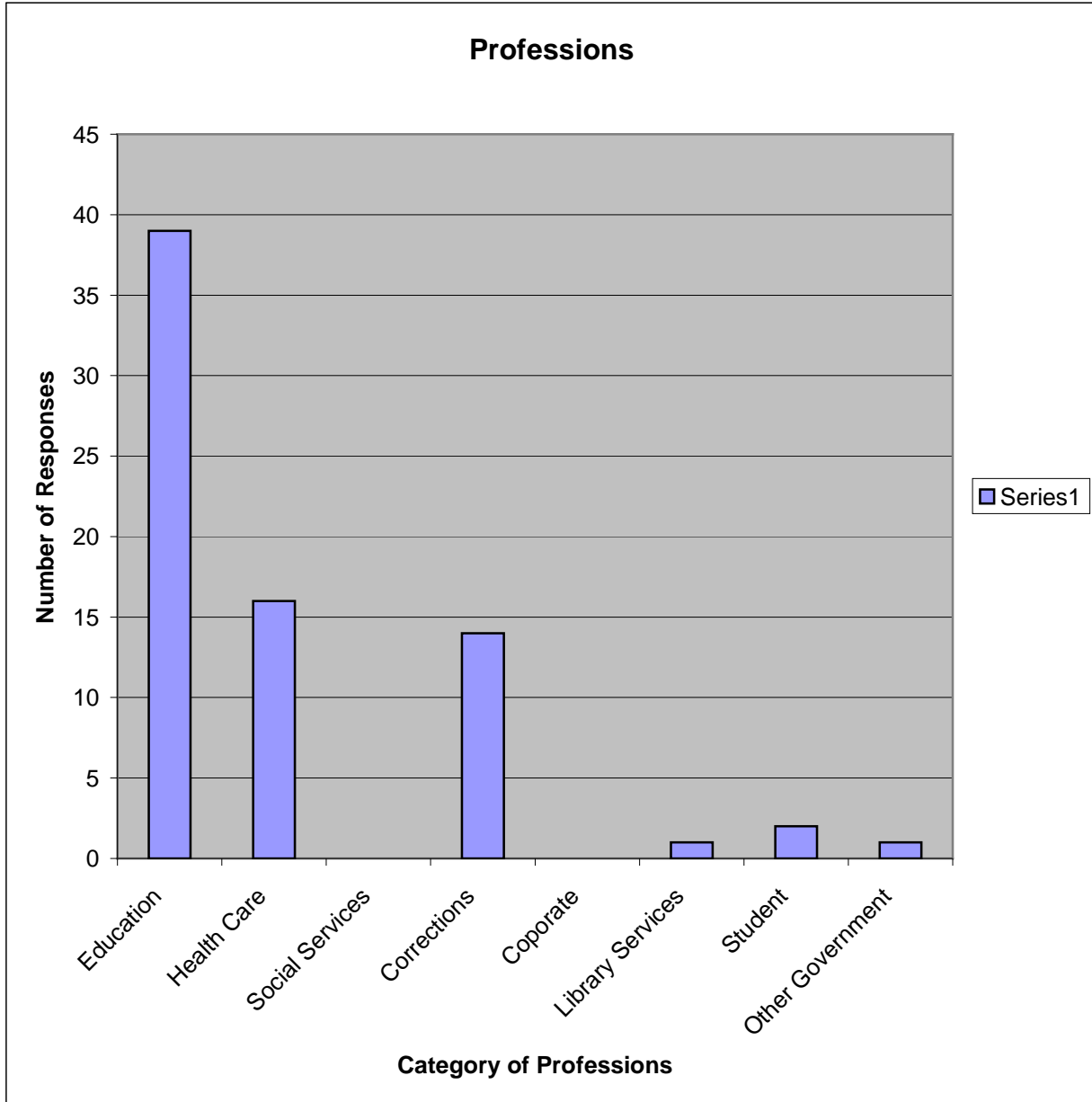
Why did you or your group want to participate in a Building Bridges presentation from the Hmong Cultural Center?



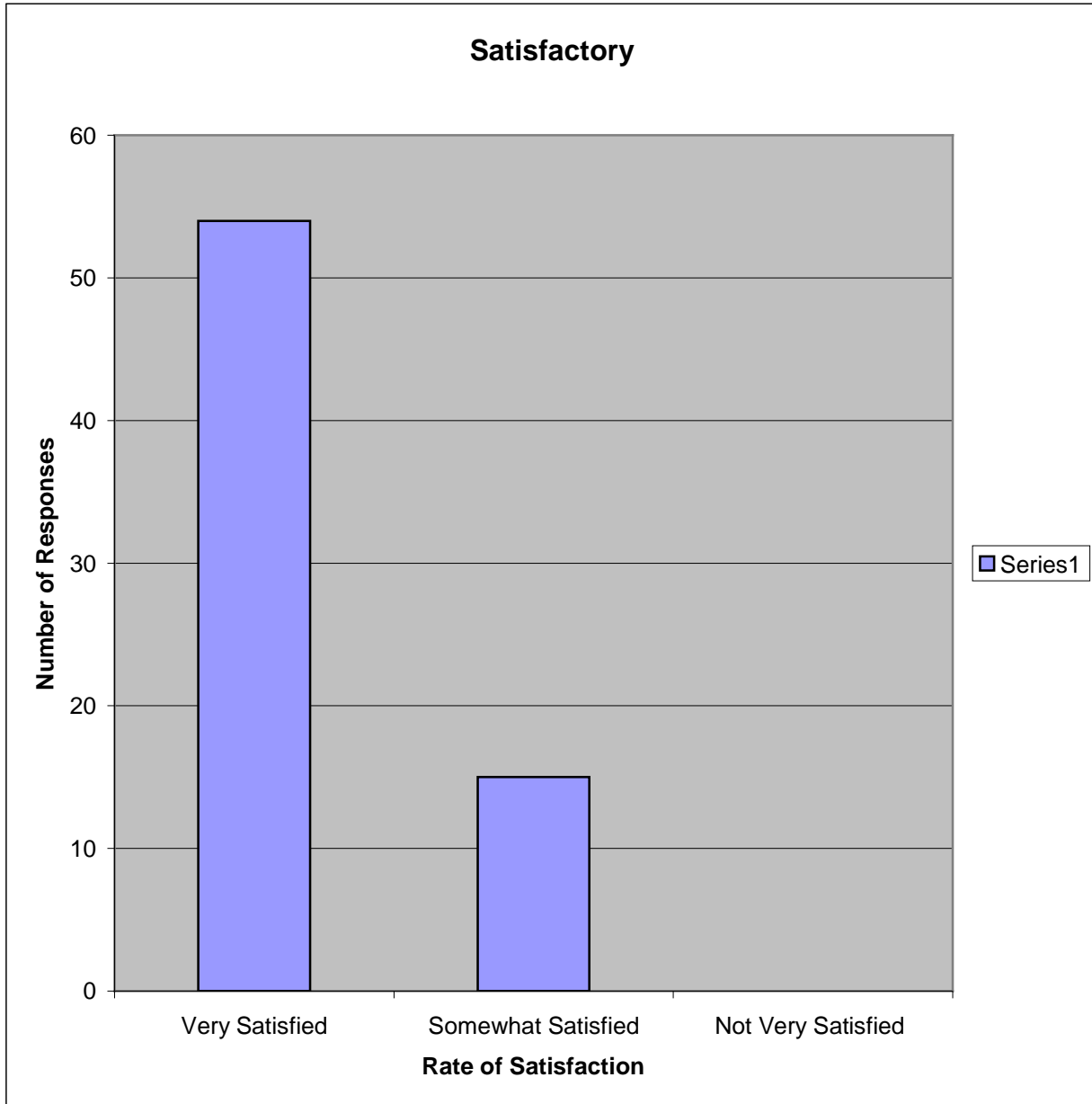
N = 69, some respondents answered to more than once or none at all throughout the survey.

Please pick the category that best describes your profession (Please choose one category only)

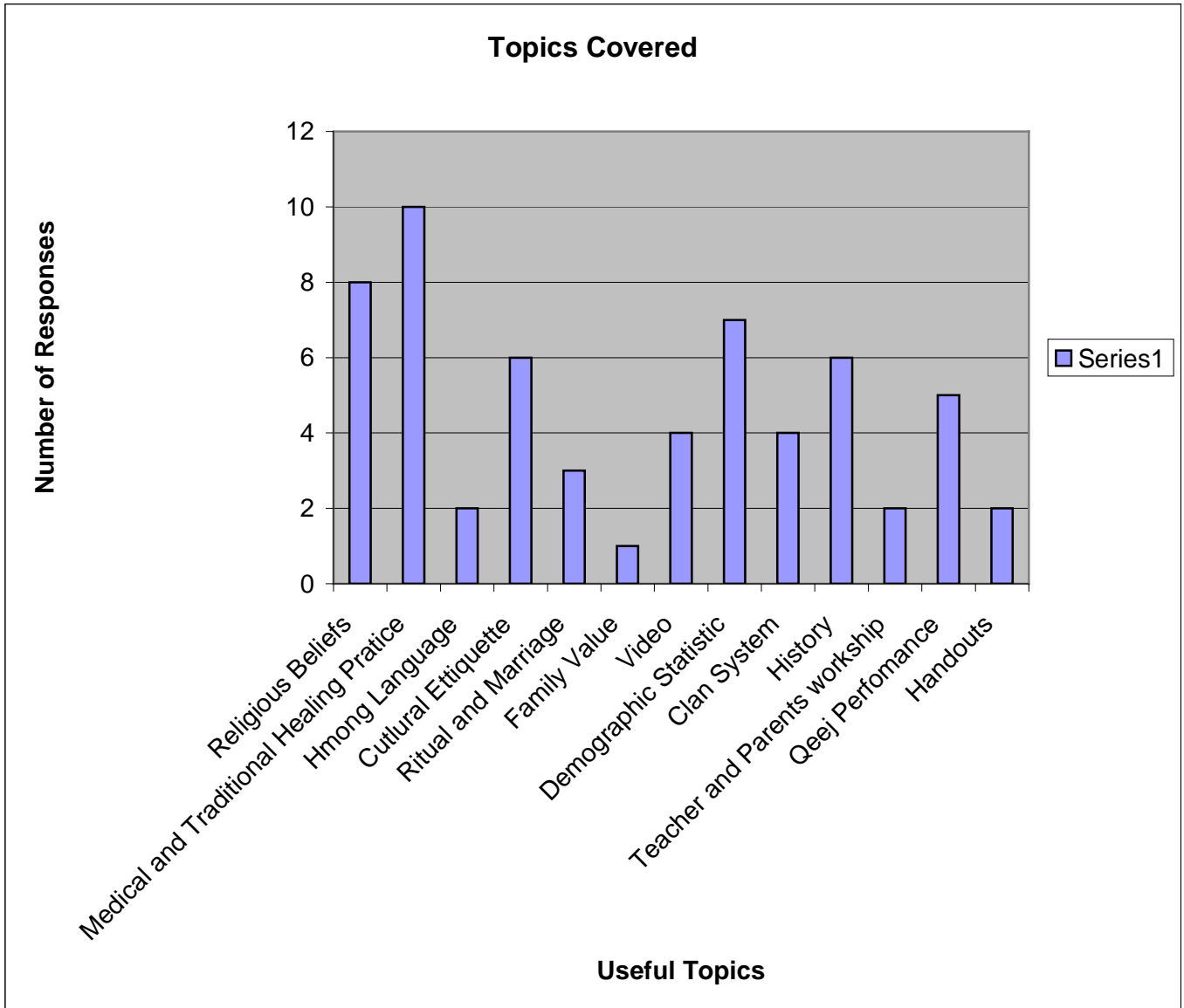


How would you rate your satisfaction with the presentation that was provided in terms of educational value? (Please choose one answer only)



One of the participants in the Building Bridges workshop notes, “At time the speaker was difficult to understand. The handout was useful to follow along”.

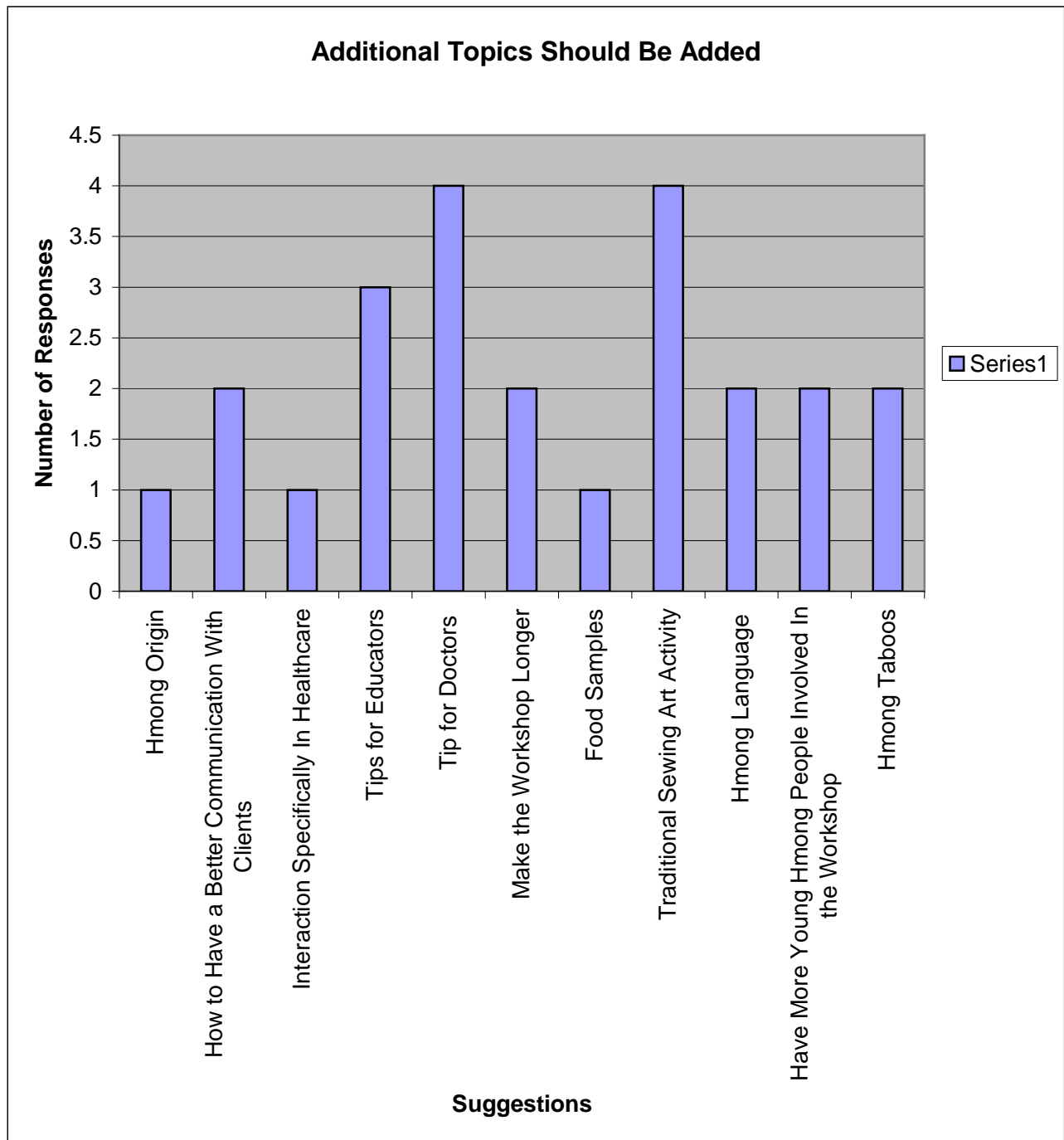
Please provide below specific examples of Building Bridges Program content that you found particularly helpful (i.e. subject topics covered)



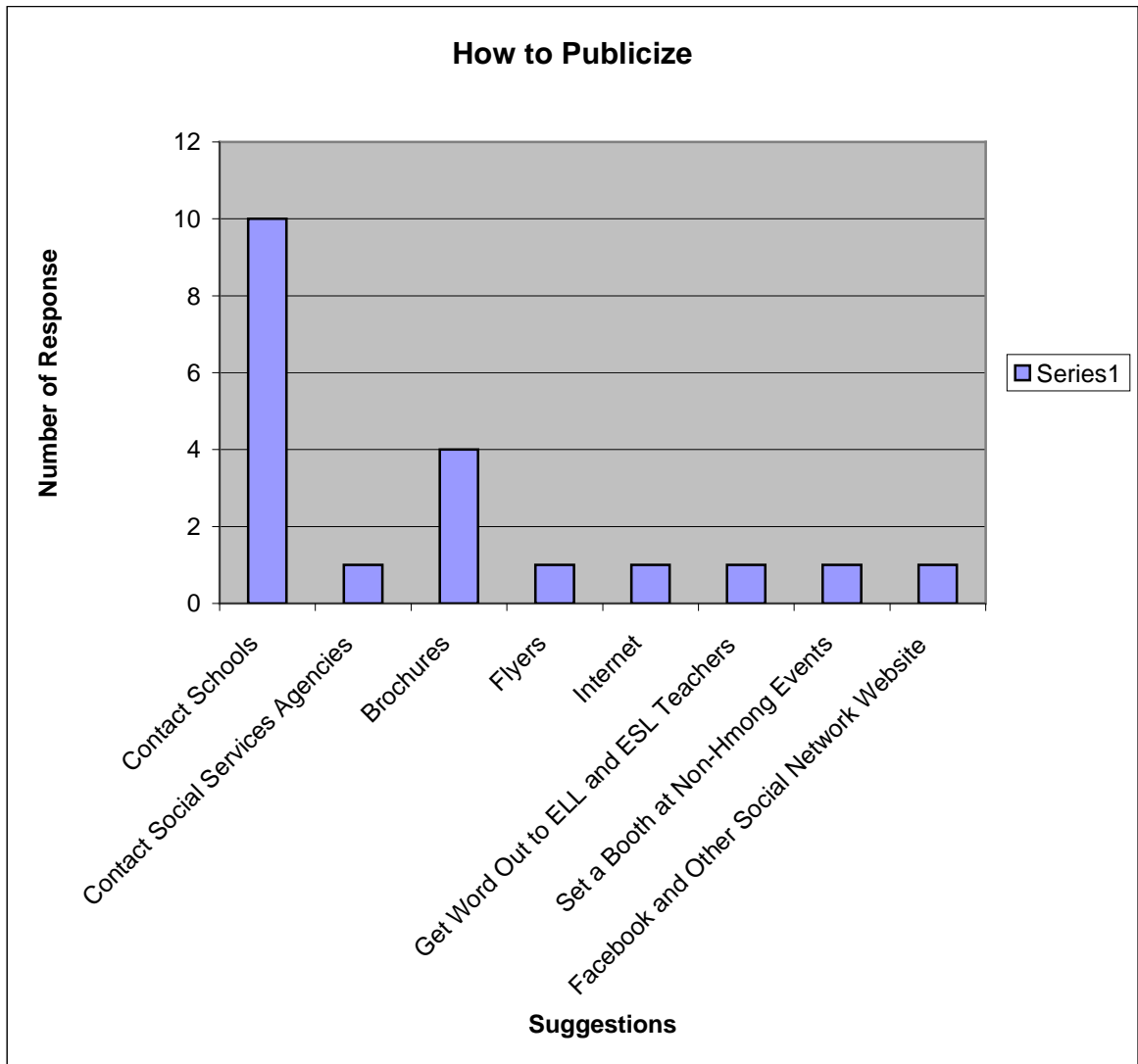
Several students noted that the video shown during the workshop was very informative, and they learned a lot about the Hmong people. One of the participants notes “The video was informative. Thank you for sharing your
